



Good Afternoon.

Our Information Technology team is aware of a number of security vulnerabilities in the Zoom Client running versions 4.x.x for Mac & PC, including a Zero Day exploit (CVE-2020-11443) that would allow an attacker to inject malicious code onto an individual's device without their knowledge. While this issue has been patched in version 4.6.11, we are encouraging everyone to check their version of Zoom & update to the latest version (5.0.1) as soon as possible. Zoom has implemented a cut-off date of May 30th to complete these updates.

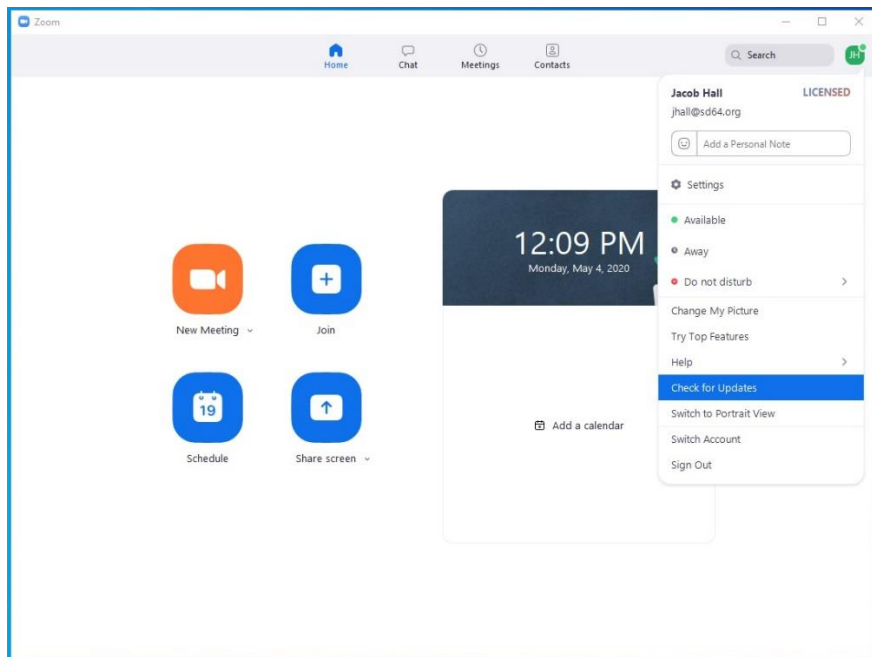
Security Enhancements

Suggested action

Open Zoom on your Mac or PC & login using your credentials. Navigate to the top right hand corner to your profile (these are generally your initials). Click once to open a drop down menu and choose 'Check for Updates.'
